Conversing with attendees, NH-ISAC member Suzanne Austin, Senior Manager at AMGEN, found there was much interest in the shared assessment concept of Third Party Risk Assessment services and in penetration testing available through upcoming Security Operations Services. Many attendees shared their intent to participate in benchmarking services as well.

CYBERFIT Shared Risk Assessments At the recent HIMSS17 conference, Prevalent shared their high-traffic booth with NH-ISAC staff - adjacent to the new Cyber Command Center. Conference attendees were dually informed about Shared Risk Assessments and the preferential pricing available for our members from this collaborated effort. Prevalent VP Channel Vertical Sales, Devin Archer, explains that “Customers tell us we are driving significant cost saving as well as increasing time to value by leveraging this new approach to managing Third Party Risk reviews. Since this approach was designed with Providers and Payers in mind, regardless of size or for profit or not for profit status, the ability to leverage the **CYBERFIT** vendor network extends to all of healthcare.”

CYBERFIT Benchmarking

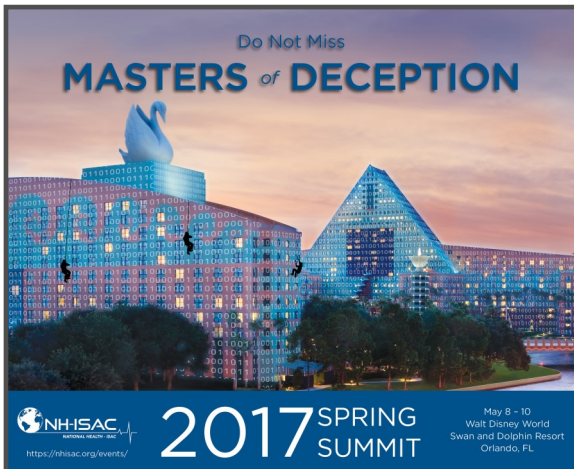
Members are inquiring about this survey. Here is sample question from each category:

DEMOGRAPHY	How many business units account for ~80 % of your business?
SPEND	In the same fiscal year, what % of IT spend was spent on ID and access management
ORGANIZATION	How many direct reports does your CIO have?
OPERATING MODEL	What percentage of authorized identities are managed on an ongoing basis?
CYBER STRATEGY	For what % of 3rd party relationships do you request and review updated sec info at least annually?
TOOLS	Which role owns the cyber strategy function?
SOC	How much did you spend on your SOC in the last fiscal year?
INSIDER/USER ED	How frequently do you conduct war games? (e.g. cyber security event simulation)

CYBERFIT Security Operations Services

Our Products and Services Committee has been working diligently to select an organization to bring Security Operations Services to NH-ISAC members. Michael Towers, VP, CISO at Allergan and NH-ISAC Board member, describes the selection process for evaluating and selecting potential partners for service delivery: “This involves a Request for Proposal type approach where proposals are reviewed and assessed across multiple potential partners, to ensure there’s a strong fit between their capabilities and NH-ISAC requirements.”

The Products and Services Committee will be bringing six Security Operations Services under the **CYBERFIT** umbrella: Vulnerability Management, One-Time Vulnerability Scan, Web Application Testing, Malware Analysis, Penetration Testing and Incident Management Retainer. When asked which of these services he is the most excited to offer to NH-ISAC members, Towers says he is “personally most excited about the Penetration Testing service. This is an area many of us across NH-ISAC have done individually with multiple partners and multiple iterations, and this **CYBERFIT** service allows (us) to build and deliver a common technique and methodology. It also allows member organizations to quickly bypass the “selection” process and leverage a partner already vetted and assessed by NH-ISAC as a trusted service provider.”
